The Desjardins RI Developed ex-USA ex-Canada - Low CO_2 Index ETF has closed the initial offering of units, and those units will begin trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX) today.

The Desjardins RI Developed ex-USA ex-Canada - Low CO₂ Index ETF (DRMD) complements the range of ETFs designed to significantly reduce carbon intensity relative to traditional equity indices.

Under normal market conditions, the Fund will primarily invest in large and mid-cap companies from the Scientific Beta Developed Markets (ex-USA ex-Canada) Universe while seeking to deliver a significant reduction in the weighted average carbon intensity of the Fund's portfolio and ensuring that all Constituent Issuers meet Pre-Determined ESG Standards.
